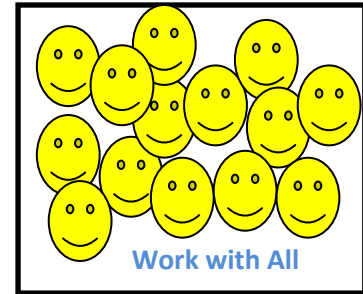
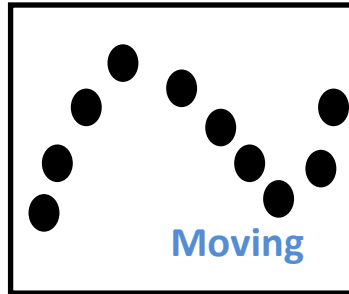
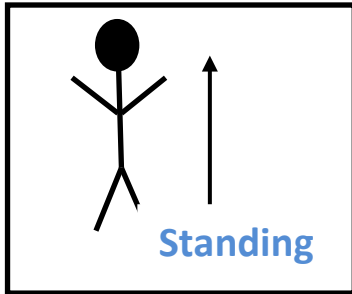


7 Reasons To Do Classbuilding

STANDING MOVING WORK WITH ALL

1. Build Positive Student Relations

The corner stone of a positive relation with someone is getting to know them as a person. When students get to know their classmates, they are more likely to respect them as individuals.
